

2016-2017 Etkin Johnson Student Scholarship Program **BENEFITS AND REQUIREMENTS**

BENEFITS:

- Student scholars receive a complimentary one-year membership to ULI Colorado to allow them to network directly with the more than 1,200 membership organization consisting of developers, architects, title company executives, real estate brokers, property management leaders and many others.
- Student scholar events featuring real estate leaders who will share ideas and answer questions – designed to allow one-on-one networking opportunities.
- Free admittance to all ULI Colorado events, including Emerging Trends session in January; Explorer Series; Young Leaders Networking Socials, Boulder programs, TOD activities and more. ULI Colorado will make an effort to pair the scholars with ULI leaders in attendance to enhance networking opportunities.
- The opportunity to meet one-on-one with real estate leaders for one half day (shadowing) targeted towards student scholar interests and coursework.
- Public presentation of student scholars at various ULI Colorado events that the scholars attend.
- The opportunity to contribute articles of 100 words or more to the ULI Colorado blog on the Colorado.uli.org web site.
- The opportunity to showcase scholar resumes on the ULI Colorado web site and through ULI Colorado social media channels.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Spend **36 hours** (or four hours per month) during the scholar year (September 2016 to May 2017) attending scholar events, writing blog articles, meeting with members, etc. ULI Colorado will work with the students to assist in setting up a curriculum for the scholar year.
- Attend exclusive student scholar events (with four events scheduled in the scholar year)
- Keep a timesheet of ULI Colorado events/time spent on ULI Colorado projects (online) to turn in at the end of the scholar year. The student who spends the most time with ULI Colorado has a chance to extend his or her membership.
- Show interest in ULI Colorado activities, events and issues throughout the scholar year.
- Contribute two articles (of 100 words or more) to the ULI Colorado blog on the Colorado.uli.org web site.
