








HOW DO I START?





CREATE A SUSTAINABLE BUSINESS ROADMAP





Identify Sustainability Commitment. Determine your long term sustainable goals and measurable outcomes. Determine Sustainability Messaging, both internal and external.



Establish Green Teams. Commit budget resources, establish recognition system, seek sustainability awards.



Assess your current state and the costs/benefits of different approaches in two areas of infrastructure changes and behavior changes (occupant/user engagement program).



Develop short term and long term implementation plans, timelines and communications plans. Develop various sustainability policies. Prepare your own Sustainable Business Operations Plan.




Implement the plan through pilots and full-scale projects. Evaluate and Measure progress – benchmark + track, make modifications and report results of sustainability strategies. Celebrate sustainability successes.







Oxford MetroCentre King Tower LEED-EB Certified Silver

- optimized **energy performance** by converting to Enwave Deeplake Water Cooling
- commissioned building systems to identify problem areas of performance
- | waste audit and enhanced waste reduction & recycling program resulted in 73% diversion rate (a 14% pre-project increase)
- I replaced existing light fixtures to maximize efficiency reducing lighting loads by 20%
- | low environmental impact cleaning policy 99% of products deemed sustainable









- currently going through the LEED-EB Processfocus on operations and maintenance
- multi-year planning effort including measuring and documenting a three month performance period
- development of new policies: green cleaning; environmentally preferred purchasing; IAQ protection plan
- upgrades to equipment and development of green equipment/vendors policy and construction waste management policy
- The Missouri Botanical Garden strives to make the most sustainable choices for the future of people, plants and the planet.

St. Louis Regional Sustainable Business Case Studies



Non-Profits

- Missouri Botanical Garden: www.mobot.org Increased building space by 11% while also decreasing energy consumption by 22%; first green-certified restaurant in MO; remodeled auditorium and sent 250 theatre seats to City Museum; recycled over 13 tons of ceiling tiles in conjunction with Parkway School District so they could recycle their smaller quantity of ceiling tiles; demands 100% post consumer recycled paper stock to help drive market; established sustainable guidelines and more
- MBG's EarthWays Center: www.earthwayscenter.org/walktalk.html a non-profit business case study from their previous, leased location in Maplewood

School Districts

- Parkway School District used buying power of 28 buildings to negotiate better waste hauling and recycling contract, then convinced hauler to offer same rates to smaller area school districts; recycled literally multiple tons of resources, reduced energy costs
- St. Louis Community College Network same use of buying power for their multiple campuses, also greened Wildwood campus resulting in LEED plaque

Leased Space Case Studies

- Manchester & 270 Office Center started greening their leased space in 1987 to offer tenants better options, continue these offerings through today
- HOK leases 1 floor of downtown building multiple green aspects to leased space



St. Louis Regional Sustainable Business Case Studies



Small Businesses

- Small Hair Salons negotiated improved ventilation systems in new lease to increase IAQ
- Murray Print Shop started around 1990 to convert to all soy inks from solvent based inks, stock mostly recycled content papers; comprehensive recycling program themselves
- Restaurants in Grove Neighborhood on Manchester grouped together to address recycling of cardboard and beverage containers
- Sappington Market and Produce Row negotiated food composting pickups from Route 66 Landscape Supply and Composting
- Architectural Firms developed policy of no disposables for use in meetings with food/drinks available, at first found
 major resistance when plastic items available, but when changed to nice glasses and dishes tha matched the
 architectural philosophy of the firm they found widespread immediate acceptance

Mid-Large Businesses

- Federal Reserve Green Teams, new environmentally friendly food service contract with Aramark, decreased food service packaging and increased use of recycled content items, increased recycling
- Wells Fargo, Reuters News Agency, Save A Lot Food Stores Headquarters in Earth City, Blue Cross Blue Shield Headquarters downtown, Monsanto, Emerson, Bunge NA, Enterprise Rent-A-Car, Christner, Sigma-Aldrich, CSI Leasing, various banks, Cardinals Baseball – all using Green Teams, expanding recycling, increasing employee awareness, data shredding services for automatic recycling, and more
- Alberici and Maritz also incorporated native plant landscaping with on site storm water management

Overall efforts include green teams, recycling, controls, energy audits and efficiency retrofits/improvements, building or leasing LEED certified buildings, reducing water consumption, evaluating ghg emissions, green policies, IAQ programs, purchasing renewable energy, establishing metrics for tracking success, transportation incentives, employee education
